Competition Name: 9th Asia Pacific Deaf Games

Location: Hong Kong

Period: 1st – 11th November 2019, Opening Ceremony on 1st November and Closing Ceremony on 11th November

Accommodation

All participating teams will reside in **Regal Riverside Hotel**; transportation will be provided from hotel to all the competition venues.

The hotel will feature:

- 4-star accommodation
- Twin/triple en-suite bedroom
- Wi-Fi access
- 24-hour reception

Regal Riverside Hotel is situated along Shing Mun River in Shatin, with easy access to major transportation networks and prominent shopping areas and attractions including New Town Plaza, the Shatin Racecourse, and the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Meals

- Hotel breakfast every morning during the stay will be included.

Transportation

The official Port of Entry will be Hong Kong International Airport (40 minutes transfer time).

Bus transfer will be provided on arrival and departure from and to the aforementioned airport upon arrival, participating countries will meet representative from the 9th APDG and they will ensure a smooth transfer to the hotel. Teams will be transported directly to the official accommodation.

Costs:

The cost per person, per night, is USD \$120 including the following:

- Accommodation in twin en-suite rooms. Triple rooms are available at a cost of USD\$110 per person, per night, (subject to availability).
- All breakfasts during the stay.
- Airport transfers on arrival and departure days to official hotel.


